



## General Contesting Rules

The following constitutes General Contesting Rules, both on-air and off-air, on Hog Radio, Inc. radio stations, including KAKS-FM, KBVA-FM, KCYT-FM, KFMD-FM, and KUOA-AM (Hereinafter “station”).

- All station contests are open to persons eighteen (18) years of age or older, being residents of the United States. Employees of the station, participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other broadcast companies, and members of the immediate family or cohabitants of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win.
- If station contest involves voting on a website, voting is limited to one (1) vote per person. Station reserves the right to disqualify any person based on multiple or irregular voting at station’s sole discretion.
- If station contest requires telephone or internet participation, station disclaims all liability due to equipment malfunctions, disconnections, or other acts, be they within or beyond the control of station.
- Only one (1) prize from station may be awarded per household within any thirty (30) day period for prizes valued under \$100. Only one (1) prize from station may be awarded per household within any one hundred eighty (180) day period for prizes valued over \$100.
- All prizes must be received within 14 days of winning. Reception of prize is the sole responsibility of winner. All unclaimed prizes will be forfeited. Station is at liberty to give away any unclaimed prize at the end of the 14 day grace period.
- Station may substitute another prize in the event of non-availability of an announced prize. Substitution may be of equal, lesser, or greater value at station’s sole discretion.
- Prizes shall be received in person at the station, 2704 American Street, Springdale, Arkansas, weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. or 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Proper state-issued identification (including, but not limited to, valid driver’s license, passport, state ID, military ID) required. If requested, prizes may be mailed to winners at the discretion of station. Station is not responsible for the failure or tardiness of prizes delivered via US Postal Service or other courier.
- A designated representative may be allowed to accept a prize for the winner at sole discretion of station. Written authorization from the winner including representative’s name, ID, and a photocopy of the winner’s identification is required.
- Via participation, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against station, its employees and agents, sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss, financial or otherwise, which may occur from the

conduct of, or participation in, the contest, or from use of any prize. Winners must sign an official waiver form provided by station prior to receiving any prize.

- Additions or deletions to these rules may be made at the discretion of station, and may be enacted at any time.
- All contest entries become the property of station. Furthermore, station may withhold any contest materials crucial to the completion of the contest.
- All contestants acknowledge, as a condition of entry, that station has a right to publicize or broadcast the winner's name, character, likeness, voice or all matters incidental herein.
- All prizes are non-transferable and void where prohibited by law. No cash substitution of prizes allowed.
- Winners are solely responsible for any and all taxes incurred and expenses associated with prizes which are not specifically provided for. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from station will receive an IRS form 1099 at the end of the calendar year, a copy of which will be filed with the IRS by station.
- In the event that a winner chooses not to accept a prize, he or she forfeits all claim to that prize. Station then has the right, at its sole discretion, to award that prize to another person or forfeit the contest in its entirety.
- By participating, participants agree to be bound by the decisions of the station. Persons who violate any rule, gain unfair advantage, or obtain winner status via fraudulent means will be disqualified. Disruptive, harassing, or threatening behavior is prohibited. Any attempt to deliberately circumvent, disrupt, damage, or undermine the contest is a violation of law. Station reserves the right to seek civil and/or criminal prosecution to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- Void where prohibited. Odds of winning dependent upon number of participants.
- Rules provided for by the official rules of a specific contest shall take precedence over any rule to the contrary herein.
- Basic contesting rules and addenda are available for review during regular business hours at the station offices, 2704 American Street, Springdale, Arkansas.
- Any and all decisions of station are final.
